

The Redding Regional Science Bowl will be held on **Saturday, February 25, 2017** at **Simpson University in Redding.**

This event is a fiercely technical and challenging question and answer competition among teams of participating middle school and high school students within 10 counties in Northern California: Butte, Del Norte, Glenn, Humboldt, Lassen, Modoc, Shasta, Siskiyou, Tehama, and Trinity. Students answer incredibly difficult questions in various math and science categories: biology, chemistry, earth science, physics, and energy.

The middle and high school winners of the Redding Regional Science Bowl competition will receive an all-expense paid trip to Washington, D.C., courtesy of the U.S. Department of Energy, to compete in the National Science Bowl® April 27 – May 1, 2017



Get Involved in the Adopt-A-Block Program


Do you appreciate a clean and attractive environment? If so, then we invite you to join with other residents, business owners, community groups, and individuals who are partnering with the City by participating in the Adopt-A-Block Program. Adopt-A-Block is a volunteer based clean-up Program for the downtown area. Volunteers are supplied with safety vests identifying them as participants, litter grabbers, and garbage bags. In addition, the City covers the cost of collection and disposal of the trash collected and after the second cleaning, will post 2 signs in recognition of the group or individual that has adopted that area. Currently, 21 of the 40 blocks in the Program have been adopted.
