2017 Redding Regional Science Bowl Winners

On Saturday, February 25, 2017, students from seven North State counties met at Simpson University to compete in the 2017 Redding Regional Science Bowl.

At the beginning of the competition there were 28 high school teams and 17 middle school teams that battled through rounds answering incredibly challenging questions in math and science categories including: biology, chemistry, earth science, physics, and energy. The teams are competing to win an all expenses paid trip to Washington, D.C., to compete in the National Science Bowl April 27 – May 1, 2017.

After several intense morning rounds, followed by semi-finals in the afternoon, this year's middle school final two teams were U-Prep 1 versus U-Prep 2 and the final high school teams to battle it out were Chico versus U-Prep 1. At the end of the day, the middle school competition was won by U-Prep Team 1 and the high school competition victor was also U-Prep's Team 1. These two U-Prep teams will receive an all-expenses paid trip, courtesy of the U.S. Department of Energy, to Washington D.C., to represent the North State in the U.S. Department of Energy's National Science Bowl.

Anything that can hold water for more than a few days can breed mosquitoes. Drain or dump all containers in and around your home.

Practice the 4 D's

- ✓ **DRAIN** standing water
- ✓ **DUSK & DAWN** avoid outdoor activities
- ✓ **DRESS** wear long sleeves and pants during dawn and dusk
- ✓ **DEFEND** wear insect repellent

A handful of water can produce hundreds of mosquitoes. Neglected pools can produce more than a million mosquitoes and may affect people as far away as five miles.
