Far NorCal Regional Science Bowl

The Far NorCal Science Bowl will be held on **Saturday, February 24, 2018, at Simpson University in Redding.**

This fiercely technical and highly challenging event is a question and answer competition among teams of participating middle school and high school students within 10 counties in Northern California: Butte, Del Norte, Glenn, Humboldt, Lassen, Modoc, Shasta, Siskiyou, Tehama, and Trinity. Students answer incredibly difficult questions in various math and science categories: biology, chemistry, earth science, physics, and energy.

The middle and high school winners of the Redding Regional Science Bowl competition will receive an all-expense paid trip to Washington, D.C., courtesy of the U.S. Department of Energy, to compete in the National Science Bowl® April 26 – 30, 2018.

Report Abandoned Shopping Carts


