

High school students answer incredibly difficult questions in various math and science categories: biology, chemistry, Earth science, physics, and energy.

The winner of the Redding Regional Science Bowl competition wins an all-expense paid trip to Washington, D.C., courtesy of the U.S. Department of Energy, to compete in the National Science Bowl®, April 28 – May 2, 2016.
