Annual Patrol and Infrared Inspections of REU's Electrical Facilities

Beginning in early July 2016, and ending in late August 2016, Redding Electric Utility (REU) will be conducting its GO-165 (California - General Order 95 – Rules for Overhead Electric Line Maintenance) Annual Patrol and Infrared Inspection of REU's electrical facilities. This annual patrol consists of a visual inspection of all REU-owned electric facilities and is designed to identify obvious structural problems or hazards that may have occurred throughout the year. The infrared inspection is designed to locate potential electrical problems and assist REU to eliminate system failures in its sub-transmission, distribution, and substation electric facilities.



The Utility's combined patrol is performed by experienced REU line inspection personnel using a high-resolution infrared/thermal imaging camera as seen in the image below. REU would like to inform customers that slow moving REU vehicles, pointing a camera out the window, should not cause alarm. REU's Infrared Patrol vehicles are clearly marked with "Power Line Inspection" and a second notice on the back of the vehicle that says "Caution – Slow Moving Vehicle."

REU's combination system inspection program is just one of the ways REU goes the extra mile to ensure you receive reliable, dependable power.
