Why recycle?

- State law now requires all businesses that generate 4 or more cubic yards of waste on a weekly basis to recycle.
- Recycling may provide opportunities for your business to save money.
- Recycling helps conserve resources and extends the life of California's landfills. It also helps create a healthy environment for our community and future generations.

How to get started

It's easy to recycle at your business.

- Make sure your business has arranged for recycling services (see below for more information).
- Use the list on the other side of this flyer to help employees learn what items can be recycled.
- Separate recyclable items from trash inside your business.
- Place your recyclable items in external recycling containers for collection.

Types of material to recycle



- Clean, dry paper
- Cardboard and pasteboard
- Magazines, junk mail, newspaper
- Plastic bottles and jugs – #1 and #2 only
- Glass bottles and jars
- Metal and aluminum cans

Don't put in recycling bin



- Window glass
- Contaminated or wet cardboard and paper, paper towels, paper plates, or napkins
- Plastic bags
- Food waste
- Styrofoam, shrink wrap
- Hazardous waste — paint, batteries, antifreeze, pesticides, cleaning products, appliances, cell phones, TVs, computer monitors, fluorescent light tubes.
