



REDDING FIRE DEPARTMENT

◦2007 report by the U.S. Fire Administration:

94.3% of California communities with a population of 50,000 – 99,999 reported staffing their engine companies with three (3) or more career firefighters assigned to each engine.

Each Suppression Division employee is scheduled to work 2,912 hours per year (24-hr shifts). This is 40% more hours than the typical 40-hour work week. Hourly rate is 40% less than 40-hour equivalent. No guaranteed holidays, weekends off work. No Social Security benefit.

Approximately 39% of the total acreage protected by the RFD (15,876 acres or 24.8 sq. mi.) is identified as Very High Fire Severity Zone.

EMS RESPONSES: 65% of Emergency Responses

- Brain damage starts in 4 minutes without oxygen
- Emergency Medical Dispatching (EMD)
- All personnel are trained medical technicians (Some Paramedics on staff but practice at BLS level)

BUSINESS INSPECTIONS

- Fire suppression personnel conduct business inspections in B & M occupancies
- Fire Inspectors conduct business inspections in A, E, F, H, I, R, S occupancies

PUBLIC EDUCATION- No current position assigned

- Fire Suppression personnel conduct station tours, school visits
- Fire Prevention personnel conduct annual school public education visits
