Subject: Letter of Agreement between City Of Redding and the Redding Police Managers' Association
Regarding the Volunteer Reserve Peace Officers' Program

Dear Pete:

The purpose of this letter is to confirm the understanding reached between the City of Redding and the Redding Police Managers' Association (RPMA) regarding the establishment of the Redding Police Department volunteer Reserve Peace Officer Program (F-92.0), and specifically how the program relates to the Tactical SWAT Physician.

This agreement limits the use of the volunteer Police Reserve Officer Program to one Redding Police Department (RPD) Level II Police Reserve Officer assigned to the SWAT team as Tactical Physician. Currently the City is utilizing Dr. Richard King as a volunteer to the RPD SWAT Team as the Tactical SWAT Physician. It is agreed that the use of the Level II Police Reserve Officer in any other capacity will require both parties to participate and approve of the arrangement through the meet and agree process.

This agreement does not set precedent or allow for more than one Police Reserve Officer at any given time. The City and RPMA agree this is a temporary agreement which will be in effect for no longer than one year from the date of both parties signature of this side letter. Should Dr. King discontinue volunteering for the City of Redding, this side letter will immediately expire.

If the Association concurs with the foregoing, please sign and date the enclosed copies of the letter, return to me and keep the other copy for your records.
