Subject: Letter of Agreement between City Of Redding and the Redding Peace Officers Association Regarding the Volunteer Reserve Peace Officers' Program

Dear Brian:

The purpose of this letter is to confirm the understanding reached between the City of Redding and the Redding Peace Officers Association (RPOA) regarding the Redding Police Department volunteer Reserve Peace Officer Program (F-92.0), and specifically how the program relates to the Tactical SWAT Medic.

The current agreement limits the use of the volunteer Police Reserve Officer Program to one Redding Police Department (RPD) Level III Police Reserve Officer assigned to the SWAT team as Tactical Medic. The City would like to add an additional volunteer Tactical SWAT Medic. It is agreed that the use of the Level III Police Reserve Officer in any other capacity will require both parties to participate and approve of the arrangement through the meet and agree process.

This agreement does not set precedent or allow for more than two Police Reserve Officers at any given time. The City and RPOA agree that this agreement is specific for two Tactical SWAT Medics.
