



CITY OF REDDING ADOPT-A-BLOCK PROGRAM GENERAL INFORMATION



Thank you for your interest in the City of Redding's Adopt-a-Block Program, which includes streets and roadways. Becoming an Adopt-a-Block sponsor is very simple. A representative from your group or organization will need to act as an Adopt-a-Block Captain (contact person) to coordinate the cleanup events. For your convenience, we will provide necessary equipment for the cleanup and post a sign in the area you adopt, signifying your participation as an "Adopt-a-Block" sponsor. Areas adopted for cleanup must be cleaned a minimum of twice a month.

The *Application to Participate* and the *Waiver of Liability* must be completed and returned to the City of Redding's Solid Waste Utility office before the cleanup events.

All persons who participate must sign the Waiver of Liability prior to participation. For children under 18, a parent must sign the Waiver of Liability for their child in order for the child to participate. Any new persons wanting to join your group for subsequent cleanup events must also sign the Waiver of Liability prior to participation. Please have a copy of these forms with you during the cleanup, as they will serve as your documentation for participating in the City's Adopt-a-Block Program. Please review the City's Conditions of Participation and Safety Requirements.

Please contact the Solid Waste Utility at (530) 224-6201 to reserve the following necessary equipment: Safety vests, litter collection tools, and orange plastic bags. You may keep the equipment for as long as you are actively participating in the program. City collection crews will retrieve the filled, plastic bags during the week following the cleanup event or as time allows. Bags and bulky items; i.e., tires, mattresses, furniture, etc., should be placed along the roadside but in a location that will not obstruct traffic flow nor create a hazard.
